Joshua 10:13 Is not this written in the book of Jasher?

2Samuel 1:18 *it is* written in the book of.

Genesis 6:11-12 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence. And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

According to these passages, the earth had become corrupt in the sight of Yahowah Alaha. In what ways was it corrupted?



Genesis 6:13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy

them with the earth.

The end of all flesh was determined. Why would it be necessary to kill the animals, also? According to this passage, the earth was corrupted "through" men. What was the nature of this wickedness.



Jasher 4:18 And their judges and rulers went to the daughters of men and took their wives by force from their husbands according to their choice, and the sons of men in those days took from the cattle of the earth, the beasts of the field and the fowls of the air, and taught the mixture of animals of one species with the other, in order therewith to provoke the Lord; and God saw the whole earth and it was corrupt, for all



flesh had corrupted its ways upon earth, all men and all animals.

Humans had begun inter-species breeding and had created corrupted forms of existence that deviated from the natural order. Compare this passage with Genesis 6:4. Is it possible that humans created the giants mentioned in the Genesis passage? Were these entities a corrupted human species?

Jasher 2:19-22 For in those days the sons of men began to trespass against God, and to transgress the commandments which he had commanded to Adam, to be fruitful and multiply in the earth. And some of the sons of men caused their wives to drink a draught that would render them barren, in order that they

might retain their figures and whereby their beautiful appearance might not fade. And when the sons of men caused some of their wives to drink, Zillah drank with them. And the child-bearing women appeared abominable in the



sight of their husbands as widows, whilst their husbands lived, for to the barren ones only they were attached.

Consider this passage in light of the preceding information. Here we see humans modifying their natural biology in violation of the original intent of the created purpose. Notice the immediate social/relational repercussion. The woman is disrespected.

***These activities described in the books of Genesis and Jasher as 'pre-flood' conditions of humanity are precisely what we see occurring in our modern society. In our day and age, however, they are enacted under the nomenclature of bio-engineering and eugenics.
